Spam/Virus Filtering Protects University E-mail Accounts

Beginning December 19, 2005 Texas Wesleyan University email users will benefit from new spam-filtering and virus-filtering software. This technology has been added to the Wesleyan email server to filter the barrage of virus-infected, spying-enabled, and unsolicited or unwanted bulk email messages that show up in university email inboxes everyday.

At this time, anyone who receives email addressed to an email address with "@txwes.edu" at the end of the address will have this protection.

This is the first phase of the Active Directory Rollout Project. Look for future announcements as each phase of the project is rolled out in an effort to enhance university functioning.
