### **University Continues Wireless Connectivity Program**

The University has recently begun offering wireless internet access in both the Law School and Main campus Libraries and the new GPNA buildings. The wireless pilot program began last semester with access on the first and second floors of the library to the internet and library resources. On the Main campus, students can have their personal laptops equipped and configured at the library check in counter with a loaner wireless card. At the Law School, students may purchase a permanent card for use with their personal laptops.

The new GPNA facility was configured for wireless access from the beginning in the lecture hall as well as the adjacent student lounge areas.

In the future, wireless internet and student resources will be available on a campus-wide basis. Wireless access points will be strategically placed throughout the campus to allow a true roaming capability.
